


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

Materials Needed: Crayons
Pencils

Directions:

Each student should be given a copy of the appropriate large picture page. Each direction is to be read aloud to the students. Adequate time should be allowed between directions for all students to complete their work. Sentences may be repeated when necessary for the students' success.



1. Find the three penguins standing on an iceberg. Color the middle one's eyes blue and color the eyes of the other two green.
2. You see a big polar bear and a baby polar bear. Circle the one that is younger and put earmuffs on the one that is older.
3. Find the penguin that is trying to catch a fish. Color its feet orange.
4. Find the penguin that is standing on the other penguin's head. Make the top one's eyes blue and the bottom one's eyes orange.
5. Find the two penguins that are walking behind the penguin that dove off the ice. Color their feet yellow.
6. Three seals are playing ball. Color the ball red and blue; then make the seals' eyes green.
7. Another seal is climbing out of a hole in the ice. Put red dots on this seal.
8. The big walrus with big tusks is lying on the iceberg. Color its tusks yellow. Color its eyes green.
9. Make the snowman's hat black. Make the stick arms brown and the carrot nose orange.
10. The little fish that leaped out of the water should be colored blue.
11. Draw snowflakes falling down from the sky.
12. Let's pretend both bears' feet were so cold they turned blue on the bottom. Color them blue.
13. Draw a fish leaping out of the water near the other fish.
14. Draw a scarf on the snowman. Color it red.
15. Draw a balloon on the iceberg beside the little polar bear. Color it green.
